

## DOE Hosting Online Event Friday with Industry on Restoring American Nuclear Energy Leadership

**Washington, DC – Thursday, May 28, 2020 –** Tomorrow, May 29, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), along with industry experts, is hosting an online event, "Trump Administration Strategy to Restore American Nuclear Energy Leadership: A DOE and Industry Discussion."
